

GIVE – CHOOSE YOUR RECIPIENT

To donate to St Joseph’s Home, you have two options:

OPTION A: Donate and claim tax relief on your donation (min \$50)

OPTION B: Donate without the need to claim tax relief.

Tax relief can only be claimed if the donation is made to our parent body Catholic Welfare Services Singapore. This is because only they have the IPC (Institution of Public Character) status which allows them to issue tax deductible receipts.

Cheque	Address your cheque to <i>Catholic Welfare Services Singapore</i> . On the back of it, specify St Joseph’s Home as the recipient and for whom the funds are meant. Also include your i/c number, contact number and address so CWS can send you a receipt. RESIDENTS

With just over 400 residents and more than 100 staff at full capacity at the new St Joseph's Home, making sure everyone is well catered for requires a team effort. Your donation, no matter how small, will go a long way towards helping us provide care that is dignified and that focuses on every resident as a person, not patient.

How will your money be used? It will be channelled to the following areas:

- **Food and provision** (e.g. daily meals, snacks)
- **Bedding, linen and toiletries** (e.g. clothes, toothbrushes, bedsheets)
- **Equipment** (e.g. beds, wheelchairs)
- **Services** (e.g. dental)
- **Volunteer-led projects for the residents** (e.g. art jamming, goin-a-shoppin)
- **Outings for residents** (residents take turns to go on weekly outings with our staff / volunteers)
- **Public education** (e.g. volunteer orientation workshops, community engagement materials and events, collaterals to spread the word about St Joseph's Home)

Your donation for staff will go to the following areas:

- **Welfare** (e.g. rent sports venues, purchase sports equipment, organise team building events)
- **Sponsorship of their trips home**

DONATION-IN-KIND

If you prefer to donate specific items (e.g. especially provisions / equipment), please email us to confirm the suitability and necessity of the item(s) before donating them. This is as we have limited space and may have specific requirements pertaining to items that you wish to donate.

For **food and provisions**, we like to keep them fresh for our residents and so update our inventory list regularly. Do check this page for updates before you donate

For **other items** like equipment, bedding and toiletries, kindly only donate items that are in good condition. Where possible, do send us pictures of the items you wish to donate (donation@stjh.org.sg) before sending them to us.
