



In view of the current threat of CORONA Virus, we have implemented precautionary measures for the safety of visitors, residents and staff of St Joseph's Home.

Kindly note that with effect from **7 February 2020**, in line with the health directives from the Ministry of Health, we have implemented the following measures:

CHANGES TO VISITING POLICY

Visiting hours are from 4pm to 8pm daily.

Each resident is allowed only two designated visitors.

TEMPERATURE SURVEILLANCE & TRAVEL DECLARATION

There will be mandatory temperature surveillance at the entrance of the Home.

All visitors are required to:

- a. Have their temperatures taken upon arrival;
- b. Inform our staff if you have returned from China within the last 14 days;
- c. Declare any recent travel history;
- d. If you are feeling unwell with fever or respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, runny nose or shortness of breath), please inform our staff.

RECORD OF CONTACT DETAILS

All visitors are required to have their contact details recorded to facilitate contact tracing.

These measures are applicable to all visitors. Please expect a longer waiting time at the registration counter.
